A Message from our Headteacher

Dear Parents.

What a lovely first week we have had at Grange. It has been fantastic to see you all after the half term and welcome back the children.

PE Kits

Please remember that our PE kit must be brought to school each week for PE lessons. The kit must contain a plain white t-shirt. Blue or black plain bottoms or shorts and be clearly labelled with your child's name. Failure to have the correct PE kit – including a swimsuit (year 6 only) will result in a PE detention.

Sports Day

We are hoping the weather forecast improves and that all planned sports days will go ahead. Should there be a cancellation we will make the decision by 9am on the day of the event and send out a parent text to all impacted.

EYFS – Tuesday 17th June – At school Yr 1,2, and 3 –Monday 23rd June – Burgess Park Yr 4,5, and 6 –Friday 20th June – Burgess Park

Please ensure your child is dressed in their PE kit on the morning of their sports day and they are wearing the appropriate shoes. Classes in years 1 – 6 will leave school promptly on their designated day and are expected to arrive at Burgess Park (Copeland Road caged areas) for a 10.00/10.15am start. We anticipate sports day to last for approximately an hour and a half to ensure everyone is back at school by midday. Our Early Years team will send out a separate letter detailing timings for the early years sports day.

Our ice cream Fridays will continue each week this term starting from **Friday 13th June**, please ensure you have the correct change with you to make the queuing quicker! Ice creams and ice Iollies will be sold for £1 and 50p and any profit made will be used towards resources for the children.



New Provider for After School Club provision 3.30pm to 6pm

As you know, Grange Primary School will no longer continue with the After-School Club service (3.30pm to 6pm) at the end of this term. We are pleased to announce **ClubsComplete** will be running the service at the school from 2nd September 2025. The provision will be run solely by them and does not form part of any provision by the school.

ClubsComplete are a well-established extra-curricular service provider operating around the UK. They will be offering three after school options each term time day as well as summer camps at different locations. Please see attached a letter from **ClubsComplete** detailing their provision and what you need to do to register and book and pay for your child's attendance. They are ready to take your bookings now.

Please note all bookings and payments made with **ClubsComplete** will be managed by them and <u>not</u> the school, you should raise any queries you may have about the service directly with the **ClubsComplete** team. Their contact details can be found on the attached letter.

Dear Parent/Carer.

We are thrilled to announce that we are the new extra-curricular service provider for Grange Primary School. We provide excellent extracurricular services in many primary schools throughout the UK and have an enthusiastic team of staff that are trained in safeguarding and prevent duty and we always have a paediatric first aider on site.

We are an Activity Provider as well as wraparound provider so we always provide a structured one hour adult-led activity during the Activity Club (first hour after school) that children are welcome to join - even if it is just for this session! Therefore, check out our activity programme and feel free to allow your child to attend our enriching activities even if you do not require the childcare! Our leaflet with themes will be attached to this letter, posted in the Facebook group and our themes can also be found online.

For parents wishing to pay with childcare vouchers:

As the clubs are Ofsted registered, we will be able to accept tax free childcare, vouchers and student grant payments. However, your child's school has recently booked this service therefore the registration has recently been submitted and the Ofsted registration number for the premises is not yet live - we will let you know when we receive this from Ofsted. If you wish to book in the interim, you are able to book and pay for your sessions. If you wish to pay with vouchers in future, we will refund the payments for existing bookings upon receipt of the Ofsted registration number. Alternatively, you are welcome to wait until the Ofsted registration number arrives. However, spaces may not be available as all of our clubs fill very quickly.

For parents wishing to pay with debit or credit card:

Bookings are now live for the year - you are able to book and reserve your space for as many sessions as you please. Note that sessions are payable at the time of booking therefore please only book what you are able to make payment for.

All services have limited spaces available and are payable upfront by parents via our website. Ad-hoc bookings are welcomed and you can book up to 3 hours before the club taking place should there be a space available on the club that day.

The sessions will commence on 02/09/2025 and will run until 15/07/2026 initially with a view of continuing if attendance is as expected.

For parents wishing to subscribe to use the service every day for reliable childcare and pay the same amount monthly via direct debit at a discounted price:

Click here to see our Membership Brochure and e-mail creditcontrol@clubscomplete.co.uk if you feel this may be of interest. Please note that our memberships are not suitable for parents paying with childcare vouchers, tax free childcare, student grant, universal credit or HAF funding.

After school club: 3.30pm-4.30pm £7.80

During the Activity club, children can choose to take part in an assigned adult-led activity for that day - themes for each day will change every term, see attached the leaflet for Autumn Term. During after-school clubs with more than 10 children, we also have alternative activities on offer for those children who do not want to choose the structured activities on offer.

Explore club: 4.30pm-5.30pm £8.95 (including food and drink)

Children will first enjoy a nutritious meal, which will vary each day, click <u>here</u> to see our menu. After children have enjoyed their meal, they will have the choice to participate in the adult-led activity of the day or to enjoy independent play by taking advantage of the stations set up in clubs; construction corner, quiet corner, craft corner etc.

Care package 3.30-6pm £16 (including food and drink)

This package includes both Activity and Explore and club up to 6pm. After the Explore session, the remaining time is a child-led free play session whereby homework can be worked on, children can read, play games or take part in other activities such as crafts and lego.

This is where we post reminders of events, polls for new themes and menu options, and pictures of what the children have been up to. This is also a great place to ask any questions you may have about the clubs and to chat to other parents using our services!

Our terms:

- Once you have made a booking you can amend or cancel this booking within 24 hours at which point a credit for the session will be automatically made to your account.
 Outside the 24 hours, it is not possible to receive a refund.
- Time limits for bookings: You are able to book any clubs of your choice up to three hours before the club commences. At the cut-off point of three hours before any club starts, the website will automatically prohibit you from booking the club so that we can cater for the amount of children in the club if it is an emergency, and you require the childcare, you may call the office to see if there are remaining spaces available but a £5 administration fee will be charged for your booking for our staff member to make the last-minute booking for you as it is quite a lengthy process to log in and override the system.

- Your account if you do not make the bookings via your online account and prefer to call
 our office, we are able to take the booking, but all transactions are subject to a £5
 administration charge.
- If you have a change in circumstances or your child is poorly, we ask that you log into
 your account and cancel their space, so our staff know not to expect them this is part of
 our safeguarding policy to ensure we know the whereabouts of your child. Unfortunately,
 you will not receive a credit or refund in this circumstance as we have to allocate staff,
 purchase food and equipment ahead of the day arriving, so our costs have already been
 made

Please note that from a safeguarding perspective, we are not covered to accept children who have not been booked onto a session. Therefore, please book your child/ren on online, in advance. If your child arrives at a session when no one else is on school site, we will accept them - however, you will be charged an additional £5 admin fee for our office team to invoice you. If the school reception is still open and your child is not on the register, we will ask them to call you to collect.

All ClubsComplete staff members are DBS checked, qualified and experienced working with children and have undertaken safeguarding children training.
