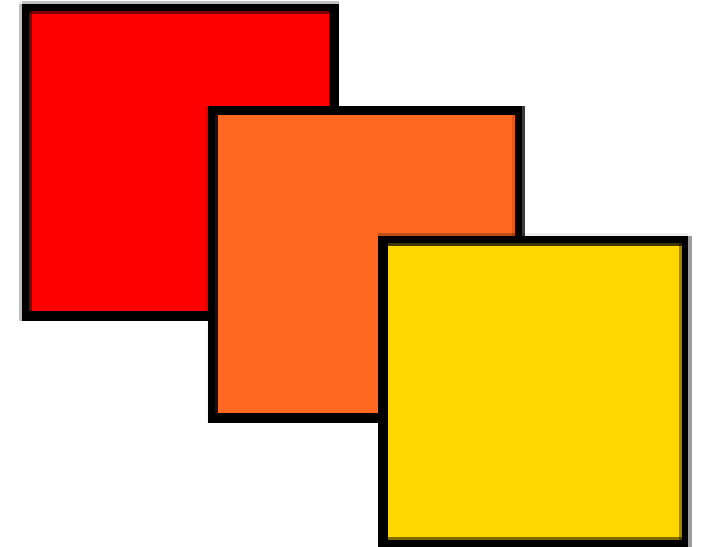

# Year 6 Trips & Behaviour

## Behaviour Expectations

Participation on our school trips depends on students' behavior. To promote positive conduct and manage misbehavior, we've implemented a trip-attendance behavior system. Each child starts with **20 points**. Points are deducted for inappropriate behavior based on the severity of the action:

- **An "Internal" incident results in a 5-point deduction.**
- **"Red Card" leads to a 4-point deduction.**
- **a "Minus 10" indicates a severe offense and 3-point deduction.**
- **"Minus 5" equates to a 2-point deduction.**
- **"Warning 2" equates to a 1 point deduction.**

Dear Children and adults,

Our topic this half term is 'Being a Global Citizen'. We will be learning about the economics of our country, the geography of our local area, about climate zones and the influence these things have on our lives.

Homework can be completed by the children on their own or with some adult support or encouragement. Please encourage high standards of presentation.

### MATHS

Maths homework is provided on. Mathematics and children are expected to complete set tasks. Tasks will be set each week and will be checked every Wednesday.

Times Table Rockstars is a mathematical learning platform which is a great way for your children to practise and master their times tables. Every child should aim to reach 'rock legend' or 'rock star' status.

### READING

Remember to read each day and get an adult to sign your reading card/book - your child should read for a minimum of 1 hour a week. Dictionaries will take place if your child hasn't read/brought in their reading record (signed). Record your book title, comments, summaries and vocabulary encountered.

### SPELLING

Don't forget to learn your spellings, each week! Spelling test will take place every Friday.



### WRITING AND TOPIC

You have a scrap book to use to complete your homework project.

Over the next few weeks complete some of these activities or make some up of your own to do with 'Being a global citizen'.

#### TRY ONE OF THE WRITING TASKS

1. Write a poem about what it's like to be a British citizen.
2. Create a weekly budget to see how long it would take to save up for a desired item.
3. Find an article about a river in the news and write your own report on this.

#### HAVE A GO AT ONE OF THESE TASKS

1. Create a graph charting the temperature of our area over the past year.
2. Design a poster which describes how to look after our local environment.
3. Find out how rivers can be part of energy production.
4. Create a then and now representation or drawing of your local area from another point in history.

### Challenge

1. Create a Thames Map collage with some interesting places set out - make it bright, colourful or abstract too!
2. Find out about the history of or make a fact file about your local area.
3. Create artwork that represents how you feel about, use, or see, rivers. Travel to a bridge and draw the river from an interesting perspective.

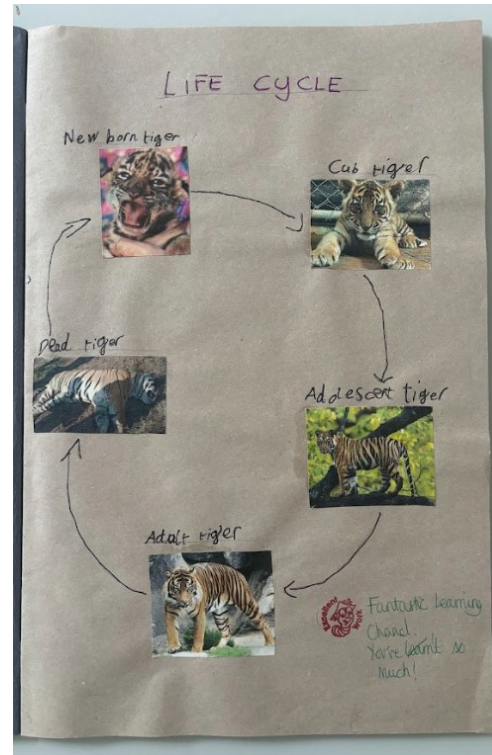

### 1. SET UP PARENTAL CONTROLS

Check your settings are up to date and controls are applied on all devices and apps.

### 2. SUPERVISE ONLINE ACTIVITIES

Ensure online activities are supervised by an adult and in a public space in the house. E.G - Living/Dining Room.

### 3. SET CLEAR EXPECTATIONS

Talk about expectations for behaviour online, including how and when devices will be used.

### 4. TALK ABOUT IT

With the schools closed, online activities will increase. Let your children and young people know they can talk to you about anything that happens online.



### 5. GO ONLINE TOGETHER
