## Topic (Geography)

Our new topic will be 'Britain and Beyond'. We will be exploring the UK, focusing on its geographical features including mountains and rivers, and comparing these to other countries within Europe.

#### **English**

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on 'Beowulf' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be using this book to help develop children's writing skills within the context of fiction texts, myths and poetry. We will look at different text features and develop our writing skills across a range of genres. In addition, we will be reading 'The Firework Maker's daughter' by Philip Pullman to develop our reading skills. Each week we will also do comprehension, reading and spelling activities and continued handwriting practice to encourage pride presentation.

#### Maths

Our first focus of the year will be on number and place value. This will include recapping and developing children's partitioning and calculation skills, leading onto addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Please continue to support your child at home by helping them to practice their maths facts and times tables!

## <u>Science</u>

Our first topic is **Changes in Materials.** We will be looking at the properties of everyday materials, the relationship between different substances and demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes. We will give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular uses of everyday materials,

Our Art topic this half term is portrait photography. We will be taking our inspiration from Hannah Höch, Dada movement, Edvard Munch, Edward Weston and Julian Opie and making links to the computing curriculum.
