# Topic (Geography)

Our new topic will be Britain Today – How can I be a global citizen? This will be our geography and foundation focus for the term. We will be exploring how the United Kingdom trades with other countries. We will also be looking at how land is used locally and throughout the UK.

# English

This term in English, we will begin by exploring the story *The Arrival*. As the book contains no words, students will need to use their inference and detective skills to uncover hidden meanings and understand the narrative. We will be writing from the perspective of different characters, creating first-person recounts and a series of diary entries to deepen our understanding of the story.

#### Maths

Our first focus of the year will be on number and place value. This will include recapping and developing children's partitioning and calculation skills, leading onto addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Please continue to support your child at home by helping them to practice their maths facts and times tables! # <u>Science</u>

For our first science topic, we will be exploring the human body, with a particular focus on the circulatory system. Students will take part in hands-on, practical investigations to better understand the functions of different types of cells and how they contribute to the overall workings of the human body.
