Year 2 Curriculum Letter – Autumn 2 2025

Topic

The children will be focusing on the Topic 'What was the Great Fire of London and how did it influence life today?' Throughout this topic, the children will explore and research old London, comparing life in London in 1666 to their life now. We will describe how people of London acted together to put the fire out as they did not have the resources we have today and give reasons to the changes made now.

English (reading and writing)

In English the children will be focusing on the texts 'The Great Fire of London' and 'A Tadpoles Promise'. Children will take part in a lot of role play to really get into character and produce diary entries and account of the fire.

During reading sessions, the children will begin to develop skills such as making inferences, clarifying and making links between different texts. All children will receive daily phonics sessions.

<u>Maths</u>

Our first focus of the year will be on addition and subtraction as well as multiplication towards Christmas. Year 2 will be learning to build on their knowledge of number bonds to 10 and relate them to bonds to 20 and 100. Using the sentences stem "If I know.... then I know" to justify their answers. Then children will explore the inverse calculation of subtraction to further deepening their mastery of addition.

<u>Science</u>

For science this half term, we will be looking at Everyday Materials. Children will investigate and experiment to compare the sustainability of each material; wood, plastic, paper, glass, fabric and metal. To develop children scientific skill, we will be focusing on predicting and writing up results focusing on using scientific language.

<u>Music</u>

The children have begun weekly Music lessons with a specialist Music teacher from Southwark Music services. Year 2 will be learning to identify and create their own rhythms, through learning a variety of songs and exploring different musical instruments.

Art/DT

Art and DT will be taught through our Topic. Children will be exploring different mediums to produce a Fire of London scene. Using Pen and ink, chalk pastel/ paint colour mixing, the children will comment on the work of a range of artists and learn to blend and mix colours. We will also be baking bread too!

P.E.

The children will receive two P.E. sessions a week – once with a specialist P.E. coach from the London P.E. network and once with their class teachers. **Please make sure PE kits are brought into to school on Monday**. Children will be expected to wear their school uniform to school and change before the lesson. We are lucky that we sometimes receive extra PE sessions throughout the weeks so it's important that PE kit is kept in school all week. Our PE focus this half term will be gymnastics. P.E. will take place on the following days:

Tuesday and Thursday – Earth

Tuesday and Wednesday - Mars.

Girls also have an addition football session on Thursdays this half term.

The children will be exploring 'What candles mean to us?' and looking at what candles represent in different religions..
