Topic

Our topic this half term will be 'Ancient Egypt'. This will be the focus for our history, geography and other foundation subjects. We will be finding out about life in Ancient Egypt and doing some exciting Art/DT work as well.

English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on 'The story of Tutankhamun.' Pupils will write non-chronological reports, instructions, character descriptions, diary entries and much more! They will be taught to apply their phonics knowledge skills when reading and writing. Handwriting and spellings will also be an ongoing focus this term. Reading homework will be set on Reading Eggs weekly as well.

Maths

Our focus of the term will be on multiplication and division. This will involve multiplication arrays, identifying multiples, sharing and grouping, Pupils will also apply their skills in reasoning problems and explaining their answer.

Science

Our topic this term is 'Rocks.' Pupils will be describing the appearance of different rocks. Completing investigations and test to check for their absorbency and reaction to acid rain as well as looking at the work of palaeontologists.

Music

The pupils will have weekly music lessons where they will learn a variety of new music skills. In addition, pupils will get the opportunity to play different musical instruments as well as learn new songs.

Art/DT

We will be focusing on Ancient Egyptian art this half term. This will include drawing and painting hieroglyphics.

PE

Our lessons will take place on Monday and Wednesday every week. Please make sure PE kits are bought into school on Monday and we will send them home after our last session. Our first PE focus will be gymnastics!

RE/PSHE

In RE, we will focus on the question, 'Where do our morals come from?'. In PSHE, we will be learning about celebrating differences.

Computing

We will focus on programming and coding with a focus on identifying bugs within the code.

Our modern foreign language is Spanish and we will focus on learning about animals.
