### Topic (history)

Our new topic will be World War 2. This will be our history and foundation focus for the term. We will be learning about the cause of the war, propaganda, the role of women throughout the conflict and about significant battles.

### English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on the story of Anne Frank. We will be investigating her diary entries and writing in the role of Anne and as her family members. We will explore her life and her experiences hiding away from the German government. We will be writing diary entries, first person recounts, letters and newspaper articles.

### Maths

Our mathematical topic will be fractions this term. We will be learning how to simplify, add, subtract and multiply fractions. ### Science
