ideas - Spring 1



Communication and Language :

In class we will be reading Space poetry, and learning about rhyming. At home, play some rhyming games with us. Talk about Space words such as 'star', 'Sun', 'Moon' 'the planets' and their names.

Local area trips and visits :

Go outside at night! What can you see in the sky? Can you see the moon? Can you see stars? How is the sky different during the day to at night? What changes happen during the day and night?

English

Keep reading the home reader at least 3 times a week, and remember to write in the reading diary!

Talk about what you see on each page, including new words and concepts. Talk about where we see these things in everyday life.

Keep practising lots of mark making and drawing at home. Learning about planets means lots of opportunities to draw circles and other shapes.

Understanding the World

Talk about the temperature and weather outside.

Talk about special days celebrated by your family.

We are learning about our planet and how important it is. Try to discuss recycling, and show how we help the planet in our own homes. Draw a picture of how you help!

Physical Development :

This term we will be doing PE! Our coach, Danny, leads our fun P.E. sessions where we develop our physical skills. We will be continuing with work on using large / small equipment including balls and hoops. We will also use some of the large gymnastic apparatus.

Personal, Social, Emotional

This term we will be learning about setting goals. We will be thinking about cool jobs like astronauts and scientists at school! Have a look at jobs around us. What things might we need to know to be scientists? What goals do we have? Draw a picture of you as an astronaut.

Expressive Art and Design

At school we will be doing lots of space themed art! At home., draw the planets, aliens, rocket ships! Can you cut and stick a rocket ship using different shapes?

Try to make a rocket ship using recycling—talk about what the parts of a rocket are with your adult.

Mathematics : Take photos of:

1. Find things around you that there are only 'one' of. How many heads do we have. How many noses / mouths / chins do we have? Can you draw a picture of one house / animal / person?
2. What comes in pairs / twos. Can you find things at home that come in pairs. Eg socks and gloves. Draw around your two hands and colour them in. Count your fingers!
3. How can we make number three? Which two numbers go together? Count out three : buttons, biscuits
