eternal*	Lasting forever.	repentance	To feel sorry for wrongdoing and decide to change behaviour for the better.
forgiveness*	Deciding to let go of any upset or anger towards someone who has done something wrong.	salvation*	In the Christian worldview, being saved from sin, leading to eternal life in heaven.
guidance*	Something that helps you learn how to do something the right way.	sin*	An action, thought or behaviour which is believed to break the laws given by God or a Higher Power.
morals*	Beliefs about what is right and wrong, or good and bad.	The Five Pillars of Islam*	The five important things that a Muslim believes and tries to do their life.



Many Christians believe that sin breaks the relationship with God. Through repentance and prayer, God forgives and gives people a fresh start.

Many Jewish people believe God judges how they live. Yom Kippur is a special time to repent, pray and reflect to seek forgiveness and make peace with others.

Many Muslims believe Allah shows **mercy** (forgiveness and kindness) to those who repent. During Ramadan, they fast, pray and try to act with good intentions.

Many Hindus believe in karma, that actions have consequences, so good choices bring positive outcomes.

Humanists think about the **impact** of their actions on others and try to make things right when they do wrong.
