### Topic (history)

Our new topic will be wild weather. This will be our geography focus for the term. We will be learning about extreme temperatures, the water cycle, earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanoes.

### English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on *The Watertower*. Based on this story, we will write a diary entry, our own horror stories, character descriptions, and newspaper articles. We will focus on using punctuation marks, such as colons and semicolons, correctly.

### Maths

In Mathematics, we will be focussing on statistics, shape, and ratio. We will have a greater focus on revision of past concepts from this academic year. Please continue to support your child at home by helping them practice their times tables! Your child should have their TTRS login. We are aiming for every child to reach at least 'Rock Legend' status. We will be setting weekly Mathletics homework which will be checked every Friday.

### Science

This term, our topic during Science will be space. We will be learning about the solar system, different scientific discoveries and the mysteries of the universe. Throughout the term, we will be implementing a number of scientific skills into our learning by doing research, making presentations, and using scientific enquiry skills.

### Music

This term in music, we will be working through 'Music Express' lessons to gradually build to a class performance.

### RE

This term we will be focusing on learning the main events in the Easter story; different perspectives of the story; how artists portray the Easter story and the main themes.

### PSHE

We will be focusing on 'Healthy me'. The children will be learning how to make healthy choices, focusing on diet and being physically active; how to form healthy friendships and how to keep calm and deal with difficult situations.

### PE

Please make sure PE kits are brought into school on these days. Children that do not have a PE kit will not be allowed to participate. Our first topic will be tag-rugby. PE will take place twice a week.
