Remember to revise your number bonds and multiplication tables as well! Continue to use TTRS and maths frame to help consolidate your multiplication knowledge.

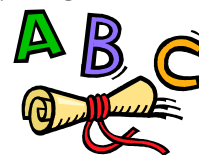
**READING**
