Topic

Our topic this half term will be 'Stone Age'. This will be the focus for our History and other foundation subjects. We will be finding out about Stone Age way of life and doing some exciting Art/DT work as well.



English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on 'The First Drawing'. Pupils will write in role and create diary entries, recounts and character description. We will end the unit by retelling the story in our own words. As we approach the end of year 3 Spelling and Handwriting are both going to be a focus in class and we will send work home to support this.

Maths

This term we will be continuing our work on Fractions. This will involve adding and subtracting unit fractions and non-unit fractions. We will then move on to Money and Time, which will involve some practical lessons using money and telling the time.



Science

We will continue the Topic of 'Forces and Magnets' this half term. Pupils will compare how things move on different surfaces and observe how magnets attract or repel each other and other objects.

Music

The pupils will have weekly music lessons where they will learn a variety of new music skills. In addition, pupils will get the opportunity to learn how to play the recorder. This will start in a few weeks and will be taught by a specialist teacher.

Art/DT

We will be focusing on Stone Age this half term and doing lots of exciting Art/DT work based on this topic.

PE

Our lessons will take place on Tuesday and Wednesday every week for Jupiter. Please make sure PE kits are brought in at the beginning of the week and they will stay in school until Friday. Our PE focus this half term will be athletics in preparation for our annual sports day.

RE/PSHE

We will focus on 'Why is water symbolic?' for RE this term. In PSHE, we will be learning about different relationships.

Computing

We will focus on creating our own Wiki page with all the information we have learnt during our Stone Age Topic.

Our modern foreign language is Spanish and we will focus on learning how to talk about different fruits this half term.
