### Topic (history)

Our new topic will be "Power to the people". This will be our history focus for the term. We will be learning about the roles and rights of women and how this has changed over time.



### English

Initially in English, we will be revising SPAG tasks in preparation for Year 6 SATS. We will then continue focusing on 'The Water Tower' where we will be writing a newspaper article, first person recounts and a 3<sup>rd</sup> person narrative.



### Maths

In Mathematics, we will be revising a number of topics to prepare the children for SATs (long multiplication, worded problems, fractions, percentages, statistics, BODMAS and long division) . Please continue to support your child at home by helping them practice their times tables! Your child should have their TTRS login. We are aiming for every child to reach at least 'Rock Legend' status. We will be setting weekly Mathletics homework which will be checked every Friday.

### Science

This term in Science, we will be learning about **evolution**. We will explore how animals have changed over time and adapted to their environments in order to survive. We will also look at different types of adaptations and how these help living things live successfully in their habitats.

### Music

This term in music, we will be working through 'Music Express' lessons to gradually build to a class performance. Samba drumming sessions will begin this term in preparation for year 6's performance during the carnival.
