We are thrilled to announce an exciting opportunity for our Year 3 pupils as part of our summer exploration into the Stone Age.

On **Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> May 2026**, we will be visiting Celtic Harmony in Hertfordshire. During this immersive experience, students will step into the shoes of Stone Age hunter-gatherers, exploring the forest for food, cooking with prehistoric herbs. Some of the activities may include:

- Witnessing the Friction Fire lighting display
- Constructing their own woodland shelter
- Observing the flint knapping demonstration, examining stone tools, and participating in the mammoth hunt!
