MATHS and READING

Mathletics

Weekly tasks are set on Mathletics and Reading Eggs. Please make sure you log in to complete tasks set. Well done to those of you who complete these regularly. If you are experiencing any problems on Mathletics or Reading Eggs please do let us know ASAP, so we can sort this for you..

Maths: Topics we will be working on in Maths include fractions (whole, half and quarters), time and money. Some suggestions that you could do to help your child, is by checking the bus times, going to the shops and recognising prices. Can they add the prices together. Could they tell you when it is a certain time to the hour or half hour using the language 'o'clock' and 'half past?' Please continue to practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Reading: Please also remember to read for at least 10 minutes each day and get an adult **to sign your reading record book** in a new box that hasn't been written in by another adult. Thank you!



Over the next few weeks complete some of these activities or make some up of your own.

Reading and Writing

Year 1 will be reading *The Lighthouse keeper's Lunch*, *Roaming the Rainforest* and *Julian is a Mermaid* to support their writing sessions. They will be learning how to write simple and compound sentences with different type of word classes such as; verbs, conjunctions, adverbs and adjectives. Last term we created our own factfiles in English.

Could you create your own fact file all about animals that live in the rainforest?

Science and Art

Our next science unit is *Making Connections*. Can children have a go at one or more of the following?

- * Drawing and labelling the different parts of a flower or tree
- * Telling you what they notice with this season and observe something in nature. Maybe you can draw what you see or write a story!
