Remember to revise your number bonds and multiplication tables as well! Continue to use TTRS and Maths Frame to help consolidate your multiplication knowledge.

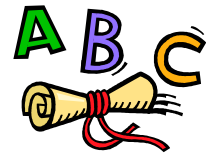
READING
