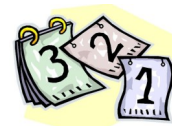

Why don't you try writing a report about a country that is special to you.

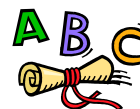
In science we are learning about animals including humans and their habitats. Why don't you design the perfect habitat for a frog. Think about what it will need and why.
